Arrival time and set-up for those renting tables is 8:30 am, for those bringing tables is 8:45 am, rehearsal begins at 9:45 sharp. Clean-up, dinner and changing into performance clothing will be from 5:45 to 6:45. Concert will begin at 7:00 pm. A complete schedule for the day will be sent to registrants.

Hudson Valley Handbell Festival/Conference Solo Selection Criteria

1. A solo piece can be no longer than four minutes.
2. There can be only one solo request per organization.
 - a. A director with two or more choirs from the same organization may request only one solo.
 - b. A director with choirs from two or more different organizations may request a solo for one choir from each organization.
3. A solo with two choirs playing one piece is allowed only if the piece is written for two choirs. (This will count as a solo for each choir involved.)
4. Registrations requesting a solo must be postmarked no later than February 28, 2020.
5. Selection of solo choirs from those submitting requests is based on the following:
 - There will be a maximum of 8 solos during the concert.
 - First preference is given to choirs requesting a solo for the first time.
 - Next preference is given to choirs that did not perform a solo in the previous two years.
 - Suitability of the solo piece for the concert.

The selection of solo choirs from those submitting requests will be made by a Decision Committee consisting of the Hudson Valley Handbells Chair and two other directors. There are also two alternate members of the Committee. If a member of the Decision Committee is requesting a solo, that director will be replaced on the Committee by one of the alternates. All those requesting a solo will be notified of the decision by March 20, 2020.
